## Now Available from the Stewart County, Tennessee Archives

Stewart County, Tennessee Deed Book Indexes, 1786 – 1893 by Jim Long

**Description**: This book indexes Stewart County's first 30 Deed Books, covering transactions for the period 1786-1893. Included are two indexes, one sorted alphabetically by Grantor (seller) and one by Grantee (buyer).

This book also includes invaluable information not included in the official Deed Book indexes prepared by the county's Registers of Deeds: in addition to **Grantor**, **Grantee**, **Book** and **Page Number**, the indexes in this publication also include:

- the Kind of Instrument recorded (deed, trust deed, bill of sale, deed of gift, marriage contract, power of attorney, etc.)
- the **Year** in which the transaction took place
- the number of **Acres** involved in land transactions
- a **Description** of the location of the land, items in the bill of sale, etc. This includes the names of watercourses mentioned in deeds, and the names and ages of slaves mentioned in bills of sale.

**Special Note**: The content of this book is available for free from the TNGenWeb Stewart County Genealogy web site (<a href="http://www.tngenweb.org/stewart/researc3.htm#deeds">http://www.tngenweb.org/stewart/researc3.htm#deeds</a>). The printed version is perfect for researchers who do not have Internet access, and for institutions and researchers who prefer to have the indexes in hard-copy form.

The original Deed Books are located in the Register of Deeds office in the Stewart County Courthouse. All of the deed books have been microfilmed, and those microfilm reels are available to researchers at the Stewart County Public Library in Dover and at the Tennessee State Library and Archives in Nashville.

**About the Compiler**: Jim Long has been doing genealogical work in Stewart County records for more than 39 years. He is a volunteer at the Stewart County Archives, and is the County Coordinator of the TNGenWeb Stewart County Genealogy web site (<a href="http://www.tngenweb.org/stewart/">http://www.tngenweb.org/stewart/</a>). He has published 17 books of transcribed Stewart County records, all of which are also available from the Stewart County Archives.
